PART OF FOOTPATH FP0219002 AT 'BROAD FALL', GUBBERFORD LANE, SCORTON PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

This Order is made by the Lancashire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, a highway shown or required to be shown in the Definitive Map and Statement has been authorised by this Order to be diverted.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of the Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use for the public.

Wyre Borough Council and Nether Wyresdale Parish Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER

- The public right of way over the land situated at the property known as 'Broad Fall', Scorton, and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up as from the date that the Authority certifies that all work to bring the public footpath described in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out, and thereupon the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified by deleting from it, that public right of way.
- 2. There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at 'Broad Fall', Scorton as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified by adding to it, that public right of way.
- 3. The Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the Limitations and Conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
